Terms and Conditions

- 1. Exhibitor agrees all displays must be fully set up by 11:00 A.M. Friday.
- 2. Exhibitor agrees no cases or packing materials of any kind may be brought in or out of the exhibition hall during show hours.
- Exhibitor agrees to arrange displays and any/all other materials in such a manner that does not disturb the aisles or exhibits in adjacent booths, either physically or visually.
- 4. Exhibitor agrees no flammable decorations, coverings, or materials will be used and shall conform to the Mobile Fire Department Regulations.
- 5. Exhibitor agrees no electrical wiring or installations shall be done except by the electrical contractors authorized by Management.
- 6. Exhibitor agrees exhibit will be open for business and staffed with their personnel during show hours. Exhibitor also agrees to licensing requirements and fees established by the City of Mobile Revenue Department.
- Exhibitor agrees not to sublet the exhibit space contracted for and shall not exhibit or permit to be exhibited any merchandise other than specified in the show contract.
- 8. Exhibitor agrees that no refund will be made if exhibitor fails to occupy exhibit space as contracted for and provided by Management.
- Exhibitor agrees Management reserves the right to reject or restrict any exhibit, which may be objectionable, or not in keeping with the high caliber of the Exposition.
- 10. Exhibitor agrees all exhibits, merchandise and exhibitor must remove belongings from Exhibit Hall by 4:00 P.M. on Saturday. Anything not removed shall be shipped to the drayage company warehouse at Exhibitors expense.
- 11. Exhibitor agrees violations of the Terms and Conditions as herein set forth may result in the forfeiture of exhibiting space. Refunding fees shall be at the sole discretion of Management.
- 12. Exhibitor agrees that in the event that because of fire, strike, government regulations, public catastrophe, act of God or other cause, the event or any part thereof is prevented from being held, is canceled by Management, the Management, in its sole discretion, shall determine and refund to the applicant his/her proportionate share of unused funds.
- **13.** Exhibitor agrees to hold the Azalea Trail Run (ATR) or its committee harmless from claim from, or due to acts of exhibitors' agents and employees, howsoever designated, and/or property of any nature.
- 14. Exhibitor agrees not to hang signs or banners outside their booth area without prior approval from the ATR Expo Coordinator.
- 15. Exhibitor agrees not to advertise, display, give away or sell any beverages, fluid replacement drinks, or water additives of any kind without prior approval by Management.
- 16. Exhibitor agrees to pay any licensing fees or sales tax required by the City of Mobile Tax Revenue Department.
